Paint Scope

Site Location:

Heritage Knolls

The following is the outline of the project to be completed at the above-named site: Three two bedroom units at 2250 Sq Ft including the unit ceilings.

Overall project Notes:

1. Water, power, and restroom facilities are available on site.
2. **Units will be occupied! Residents will move belongings to the center of each room.**
3. Bidding contractors must view site to evaluate conditions.
4. Contractor is responsible for bidding based on necessary labor, means and methods of construction, and all requirements to complete the scope of work.
5. Bids can be submitted via email and must be received by **September 16th, 2026**

General Specifications

1. All holes (nail holes, dings, and other wall damage) are to be addressed prior to painting.
2. Walls that need to be patched must be primed before painting.
4. Outlet and light switch covers are to be removed before painting and replaced after painting is complete.
5. Paint all walls with two (2) coats of agency-supplied paint.
6. Paint all ceilings with agency-supplied paint.

Property Specific Specifications:

Heritage Knolls units will need white closet doors and white window casing painted with agency supplied enamel paint. (Where applicable)

- d) Contractor agrees to contact the PMHA, in advance, if a completion date cannot be met.
- e) Contractor hereby agrees that it is an Equal Opportunity Employer and all employees are hired without regard to their race, color, age, creed, sex, handicap or national origin.
